

THE GOIZUETA FOUNDATION SCHOLARSHIP

The Goizueta Foundation has provided the Georgia Institute of Technology with an endowment to establish programs designed to recruit and advance students of Hispanic/Latino origin in higher education. The Goizueta Foundation Scholarship is intended to attract those students interested in pursuing an undergraduate degree at Georgia Tech.

Scholarship recipients will be incoming freshmen who have superior academic accomplishments and demonstrated leadership skills. The Goizueta Foundation Scholars will be expected to maintain a high level of academic achievement and participate in stewardship activities in conjunction with The Goizueta Foundation Faculty and Fellows. Eligibility: Applicants must be exceptional students **admitted and enrolled full-time** at Georgia Tech. All prospective students interested in being considered for The Goizueta Foundation Scholarship must submit The Goizueta Foundation Scholarship Application and Essay to jorge.breton@ssc.gatech.edu and a complete application for financial aid to the Office of Scholarships and Financial Aid by **March 1st**.

The Goizueta Foundation Scholarship is a need-based award. Any interested student may submit an essay; however, eligibility is determined by the Office of Scholarships and Financial Aid Services and only eligible students will be considered. The Goizueta Foundation Scholarship may be held in addition to any other scholarship, e.g. HOPE, President's Scholarship, etc.

Award: The Goizueta Foundation Scholarship provides an annual award disbursed in two payments during the academic year. The award amount is determined on an individual basis. The Goizueta Foundation Scholarship is renewable for up to four years (eight semesters) based upon the student's satisfactory academic performance, progress towards their degree, and participation in events and activities sponsored by the office of the Hispanic Initiatives@ Georgia Tech.
